### Dr. Biyani delivered a lecture in QIP at Birla Institute of Technology, Mesra-Ranchi

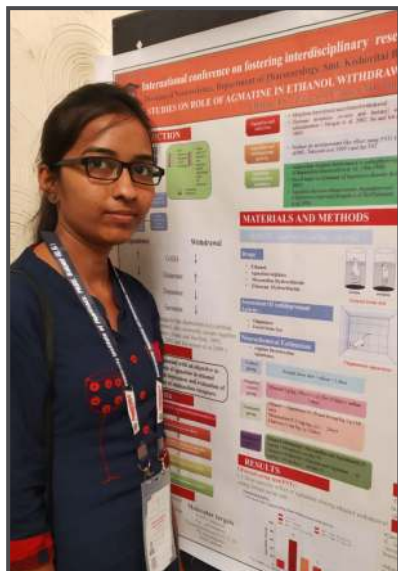

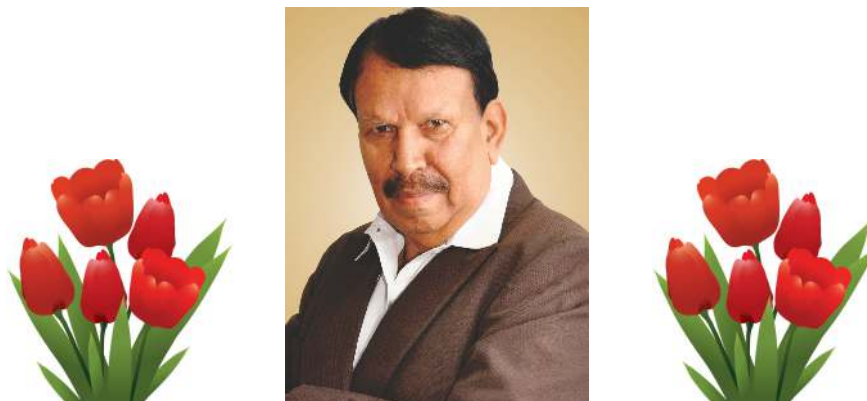
### Dr. Rashmi Trivedi
