**PROF. DR. BHUSHANKUMAR SATHE AWARDED BEST RESEARCH PAPER AWARD IN POSTER CATEGORY**



Dr. Bhushankumar Sathe presented his Research Work in form of Poster at SPER Annual 7th International Conference in Association with Abdur Rehman Crescent University, Chennai on 24th Feb.2018. Title of the Research Paper was Synthesis of Novel Fluorobenzothiazoles Schiff's Base: As Possible Antifungal Agents. He had carried detailed synthesis of 2aminobenzothiazole from Fluorochloro Aniline to get Schiff's Base reacted with 4nitrobenzaldehyde further synthesized 20 novel derivatives which were characterized by TLC, Elemental Analysis, followed by Spectroscopic studies

UV, Infrared, NMR studies and molecular weight of derivatives were obtained from Mass spectroscopy. All 10 novel derivatives of Fluorobenzothiazoles Schiff's Base were screened for Antifungal activity against 3 strains of fungi using Clotrimazole and Griseofulvin as standard. Results were near to Standards used. Dr. Cristofer Barry had detailed interaction with evaluation of scientific poster and appreciated original research. Dr. Sathe was awarded as Best Research Paper amongst all participants. Award was given by hands of Dr. H. Devaraj, Vice Chairman UGC, Dr. S. H. Ansari Ex. Vice Chancellor Jamia Hamdard University Delhi, Dr. Nagaich Upendra Secretary SPER.

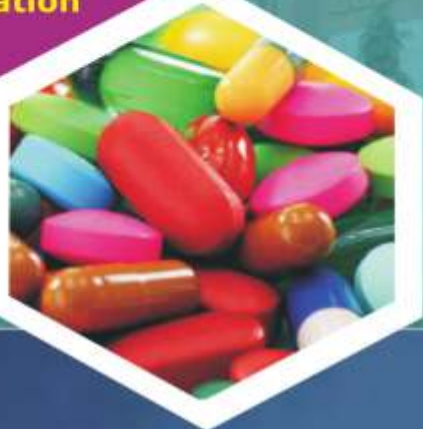
