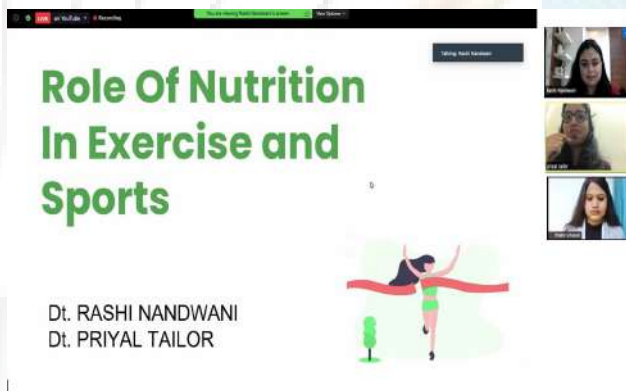
### Workshop on "Registration of SWAYAM Courses-2020" 3rd Dec. 2020

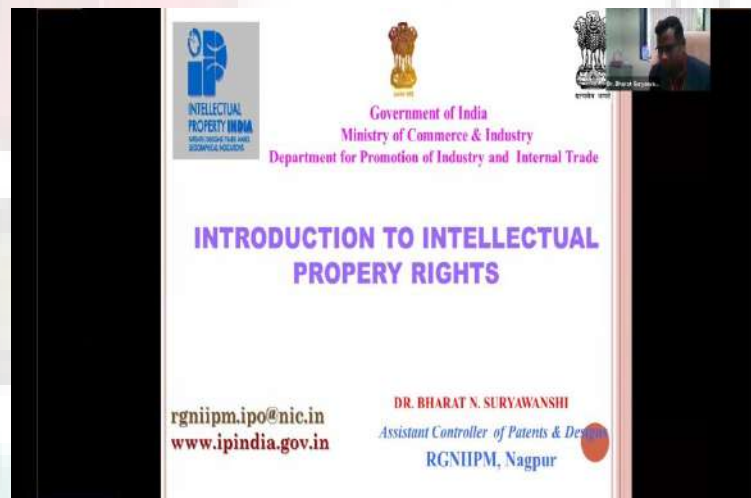
Webinar on "Role of Nutrition in Sports" organized at DY Patil University School of Pharmacy, Navi Mumbai

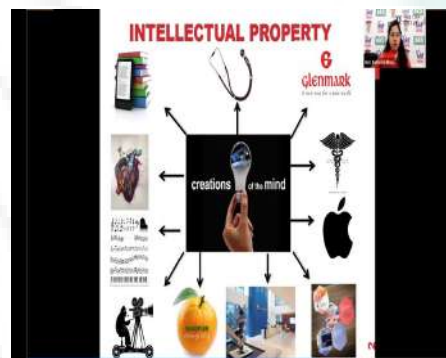
